




BU Admissions

- Carefully considers the context of a student's academic environment together with life experiences and background








Class Size

An Important Update from BU Admissions

Boston University is test optional for Fall 2021/Spring 2022 Applicants.

This policy applies to all BU undergraduate schools and colleges, and all scholarship programs.

If English is not your primary language, you must still submit official results from the testing agency.

MERIT SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES AT BOSTON UNIVERSITY


Trustee Scholarship

- Full Cost of Tuition & Fees for all four years

- No additional step needed to be considered
