APPLICANT TYPE

- > At the UW, a student's applicant type is determined by their immigration status that they will have by the time they enroll at the UW.
- > Applicant type is not determined by where the student received their education or where they currently reside.

WHO IS AN INTL FR APPLICANT?

INTERNATIONAL FRESHMAN APPLICANT

- > **International applicant = primarily F1 status**

FRESHMAN APPLICANT

- > **U.S. citizen or U.S. permanent resident**
- > **Dual citizenship (U.S. and another country)**
- > **A, E, I, G, K, and V visas**

English Proficiency Requirement for International Students

	TOEFL (IBT)	IELTS	Duolingo*
Minimum score required	76	6.0	105
Recommended score	92	7.0	N/A

**Duolingo will be accepted for autumn 2021 admission – minimum score of 105*

Students may submit SAT or ACT instead of TOEFL/IETLS/Duolingo if:

- English was the primary language of instruction of their high school AND
- They received a minimum average grade of B in 10 & 11th grade English composition courses AND
- They have a minimum SAT Evidence-Based Reading and Writing score of 580 or ACT English score of 22.

**Deadline to take an English proficiency test:
December 31, 2020**

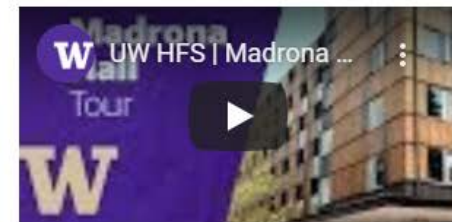

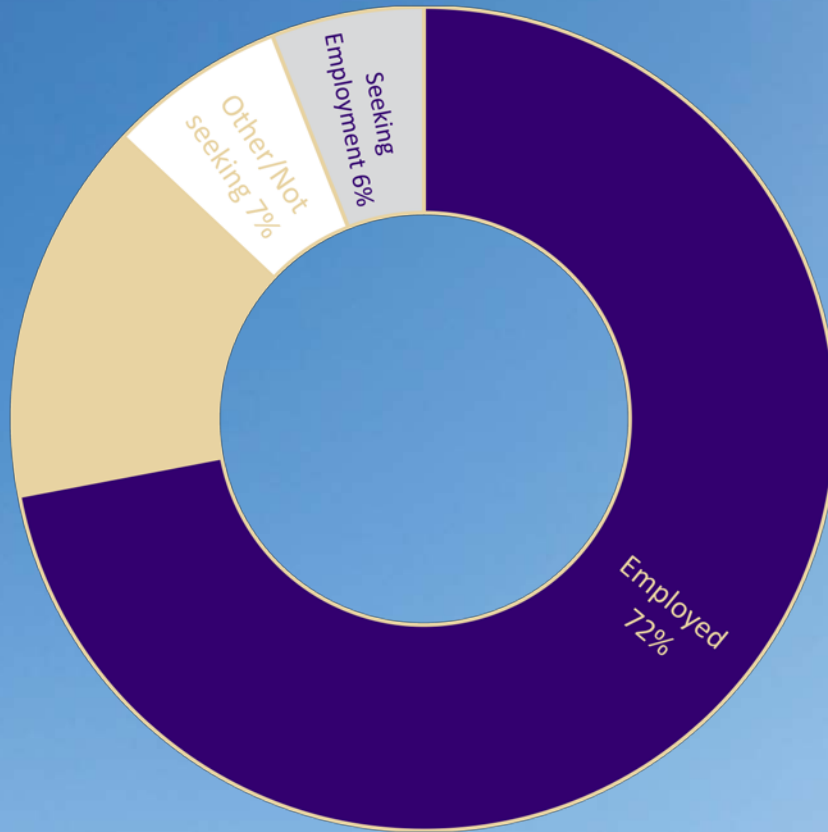
