INTERNATIONAL FRESHMAN APPLICANT

> International applicant = primarily F1 status

FRESHMAN APPLICANT

- > U.S. citizen or U.S. permanent resident
- > Dual citizenship (U.S. and another country)
- > A, E, I, G, K, and V visas

Recommended score	92	7.0	N/A

^{*}Duolingo will be accepted for autumn 2021 admission – minimum score of 105

Students may submit SAT or ACT instead of TOEFL/IETLS/Duolingo if:

- English was the primary language of instruction of their high school AND
- They received a minimum average grade of B in 10 & 11th grade English composition courses <u>AND</u>
- They have a minimum SAT Evidence-Based Reading and Writing score of 580 or ACT English score of 22.

Deadline to take an English proficiency test: December 31, 2020




