English Proficiency

(international students only)

- International students requiring a visa to study in the U.S. are required to submit an English proficiency exam that meets the UW minimum admission requirement. English proficiency is considered in the holistic review.
- Exams must be taken on or before December 31, 2022.

Test score requirement

	TOEFL (iBT)	IELTS	Duolingo (DET)
Minimum score required	76	6.0	105
Recommended score	92 or higher	7.0 or higher	120 or higher

- Review alternatives to English proficiency exams using SAT or ACT scores instead of TOEFL, IELTS, or Duolingo.

- > **December 31** Deadline to submit English proficiency exam
- > **MARCH 1-15** Decision notification
- > **MAY 1** Deadline to accept offer
