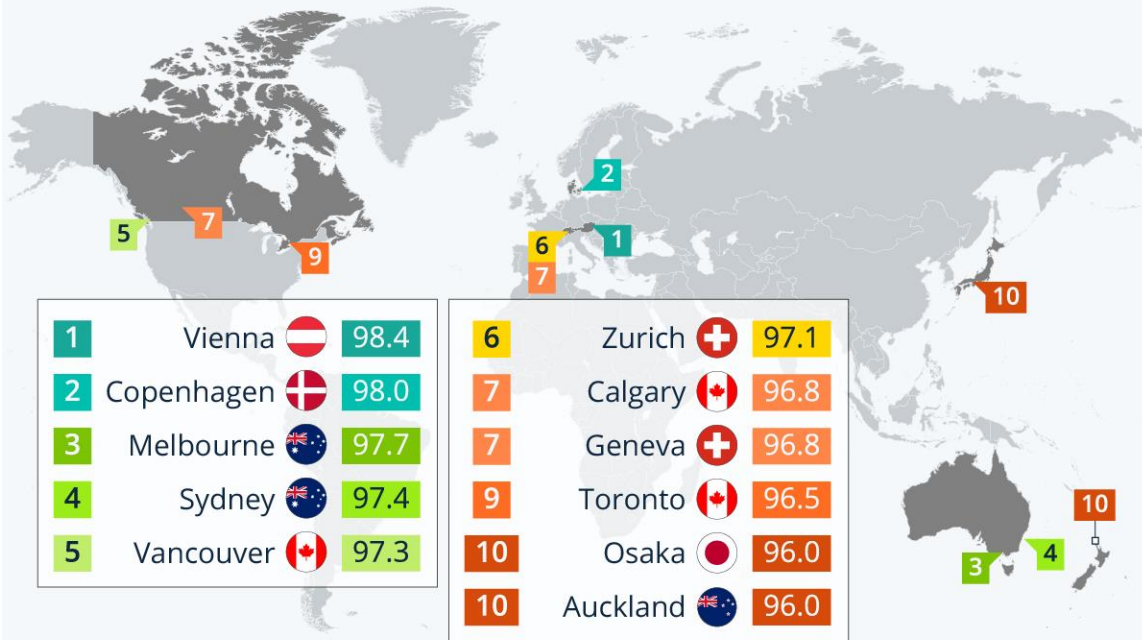

The survey assesses 173 cities, ranking them according to their stability, healthcare, culture and environment, education and infrastructure.

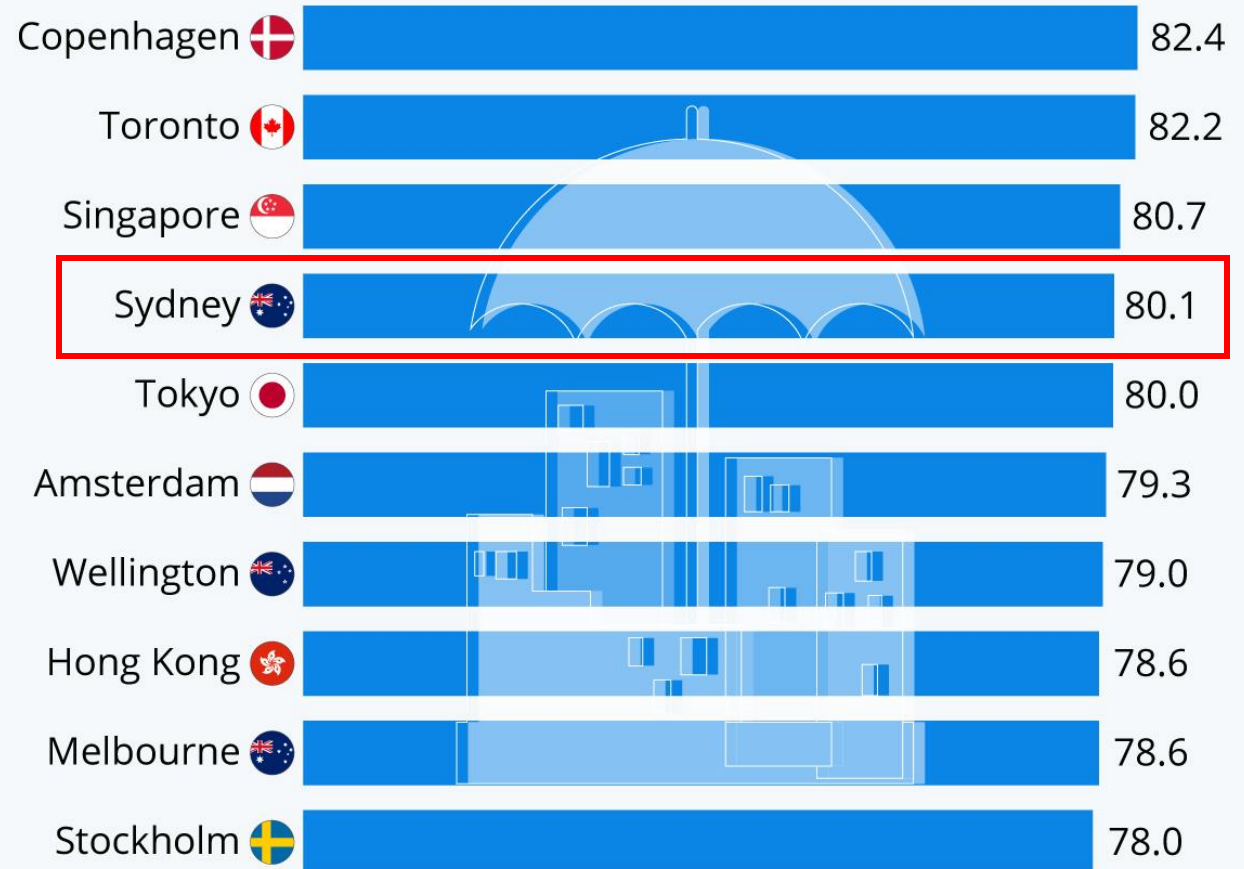

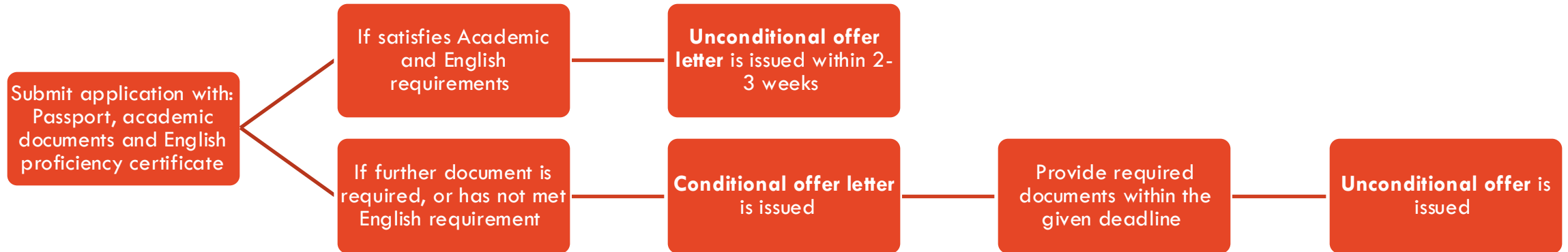
